Campus of Caring is an organization dedicated to building a 12 bed non-profit hospice home on the South Shore to be managed by the Norwell VNA and Hospice.

With an increasingly aging population and the constant need for quality health care, there is a growing demand for hospice services. In Massachusetts, there are only nine hospice homes, and **NONE** of these are conveniently located to South Shore residents.

Hospice is specialized care for people with life-limiting illnesses. It is care that provides comfort and quality of life, when curative care is no longer an option.

A hospice team of professionals provides expert pain and symptom management, physical, emotional and spiritual support for patients and support for their loved ones while in the hospice home. Families and loved ones are always welcome to visit.



Each room will have a private bath.

Hospice services are a mandated Medicare benefit, covered by Medicaid when appropriate, and also by most insurance providers. Individuals are able to receive these services in their home, but for a myriad of reasons, this is not always possible. Providing 24/7 care for people with advanced illness can be daunting to a single person, impossible for children who live a distance away, or economically unrealistic for a spouse, sibling, parent, or child who has to remain working. A hospice home is a welcome option for such patients and families. In a hospice home the patient can live in a comfortable setting supported and cared for by the hospice staff, day and night. Patients have their own private room, personalized with meaningful possessions. Families and friends are encouraged to visit, and are able to share common living areas, a family kitchen, and enjoy the outside walking paths and gardens

Since this home will be operated as a non-profit facility, room and board at the Campus of Caring home will be more affordable than a nursing facility or hospital.
